***Pediatrics in Review* Editorial Board Member Responsibilities**

1. Recommend review article authors. Authors should be experts able to discern issues important in the clinical care of children.
2. Assist in the follow-up of invited authors who have been recommended by you.
3. Assist in recruiting articles from your colleagues for submission to the journal.
4. Complete a prompt, thorough review of the articles assigned by the editor in chief.
5. Submit, from time to time at the request of the editor, a commentary, an article, or a short “In Brief” article.
6. Solicit ideas and opinions from your colleagues and residents regarding content and utility of the journal.
7. Attend the *Pediatrics in Review* Editorial Board annual meeting that is held in conjunction with the AAP National Conference and Exhibition, including mid-year conference calls.
8. Recommend qualified individuals to fill open positions on the *Pediatrics in Review* Editorial Board and to serve as reviewers.
9. Be an ambassador for the journal and its overall mission to provide ongoing information that will improve the health of children.
10. Declare a conflict of interest if asked to review an article that in any substantive way would present a conflict; also declare if you are a member of another editorial board.
